

RICHMOND SPORTS AWARD NOMINATION GUIDE

The Richmond Sports Awards Committee is looking for nominees for the 19th Annual Richmond Sports Awards, for athletic accomplishments that have occurred in 2017. Categories include:

Youth Female: Youth Male:	Any (female / male) athlete from Richmond, under 18 years of age as of December 31, 2017, who competed on a community team or in an individual sport in 2017 is eligible.
High School Female: High School Male:	Any (female / male) athlete from Richmond, who was enrolled in a secondary school, who competed on a school team or in an individual sport representing their school in 2017 is eligible.
Junior Female: Junior Male:	Any (female / male) athlete from Richmond, age 18 to under 21 years of age as of December 31, 2017, who competed on a community team or in an individual sport in 2017 is eligible.
Post Secondary Female: Post Secondary Male:	Any (female / male) athlete from Richmond, enrolled as a full time student in an accredited or recognized college or university, and who competed on a team or in an individual sport representing his / her school in 2017 is eligible.
Adult Female: Adult Male:	Any (female / male) athlete from Richmond, 21 to under 55 years of age on December 31, 2017, who competed on a team or in an individual sport in 2017 is eligible.
Senior Female: Senior Male:	Any (female / male) athlete in Richmond, age 55 and over on December 31, 2017, who competed on a team or individually in community, provincial, national or international sports in 2017 is eligible.
Special Olympics:	Any (female / male) athlete from Richmond, who competed in a Special Olympics sport in 2017.
Athletes with a Disability:	Any (female / male) athlete with a disability, from Richmond, who demonstrated extraordinary athletic performance, and who competed on a team or in an individual sport in 2017 is eligible.
Female Youth Team: Male Youth Team: Mixed Youth Team:	Any (mixed / female / male) youth team under 19 years of age and older, that competed in and represented the City of Richmond in 2017 at the completion of their sport season is eligible.
Adult Team:	Any (mixed / female / male) adult team 19 years of age and older, that competed in and represented the City of Richmond in 2017 at the completion of their sport season is eligible.
Coach:	Any coach who has been responsible for coaching at a Richmond amateur team(s) and/or Richmond individuals at any level of athletic competition in 2017 is eligible.
Official:	Any Richmond based referee or umpire in community, provincial, national, or international sports in 2017.
Administrator:	Any Richmond based individual contributing in a way other than as an athlete or official to a community, provincial, national or international sports organization in 2017.

NOMINATION TIPS:

- Nominees will be judged for their performance during the calendar year of 2017 only.
- Describe the 2017 accomplishments of the nominee in his/her chosen sport. Supply current and relevant Information including community ties, length of time involved, and extraordinary successes. The nominator should attempt to paint a complete picture of the nominee, as the Richmond Sports Awards Selection Committee will be relying solely on this information to base their decision.
- Eligible athletes are those who have resided in the City of Richmond for the 2017 calendar year, or those who received a majority of their youth sport development in the City of Richmond before relocating.
- Nominations must be on the Richmond Sports Awards Nomination Form. Typewritten or word-processed nominations are preferred. Nominations **will not** be accepted verbally or by telephone.
