Bob confirmed that 9 inductee recommendations had been made to the City with the ceremony yet to be confirmed but probably in November with a new location of City Council Chambers.

Bob reminded everyone that the deadline for 2018 was December 31, 2017 and application forms were available on the web site. Bob asked that submissions be made as soon as possible.

## 9. Sport Hosting Update

Pam announced that a new Co-ordinator would be hired by the end of September as she would be taking maternity leave and the new Co-ordinator would be introduced at the October meeting of RSC. On November 3<sup>rd</sup> Jordan Mottl would be taking over the Manager role. Jim asked that the committee be informed of any future staff changes.

Pam confirmed that the next grant dates were September 25 thru October 22<sup>nd</sup> for events January thru December, 2018.

## 11. Sports Awards Report

Terry announced that McMath School had agreed to be the venue for the next event to be held on April 26, 2018. Terry emphasized the need for nominations to be submitted prior to the deadline of December 31, 2017. Jim encouraged all sports groups to submit names as soon as possible. ## 12. KidSport

Bob reviewed the displayed financial statistics, case statistics and noted that there had been an increase in the number of girls applying i.e. 65% boys and 35% girls. Bob continued that he would be meeting with the principals of the schools to promote KidSport applications.

Bob concluded that finances indicated a deficit but funds would be received shortly i.e. \$5000 from the credit union and \$3/4000 from the Nations Cup. Bob noted that \$85,000 has been given in grants to date which was an increase of 25% over 2016.

Jim referred to the updates received to date from Richmond Cricket Club, Richmond City Baseball, Richmond Little League Baseball and Richmond Tennis Club and stated that a committee would be formed to review the updated Facility Needs Assessment prior to submission to the City.
